

#### **Year 7-8 Formal Assessment**

- 1.Mid point assessment in either listening or reading(minimum) + written RAP
- 2.Assessment of all AT before RP1
- 3. Mid point assessment in either listening or reading(minimum) + written RAP
- 4. Assessment of all AT before RP2
- 5. Mid point assessment in either listening or reading(minimum) + written RAP
- 6. Assessment of all AT before RP3

NB: There can be some informal assessment of pupil's speaking skills in class but a minimum of 1 formal assessment (preference for 2) to be completed during the year.
