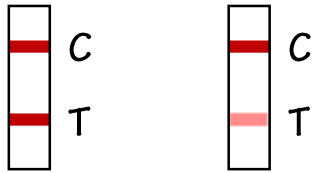


# What to do if your child tests positive using a Lateral Flow Device at home.

My child has tested **positive** using a Lateral Flow Device (Self Test)



Positive Results

- You must report your result to the Government website [www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result](https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result)
- You must report your result to school.
- ✓ Between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm please ring the school attendance office 01942 511987 extension 7505
- ✓ Out of these hours – please email the school office [DTWoffice@deantrustwigan.co.uk](mailto:DTWoffice@deantrustwigan.co.uk)

- If you get a positive result it means your child is currently infected with coronavirus and risks infecting others. When you report your result you will be provided with further information on the next steps to take.
- You must order a confirmatory PCR test\* to confirm the result.
- Your child and all members of their household plus any support bubbles they are part of will need to self-isolate immediately in line with NHS Test and Trace guidance for 10 days.

\*Confirmatory PCR tests are not needed if the test was conducted at the Asymptomatic Test Site at school.
